PACKING SUGGESTIONS

Please resist the tendency to overpack. Fishing partners may coordinate packing of some items to avoid unnecessary duplication. We recommend a durable, water-resistant, lockable, top-zipper, duffel as the checked luggage. Carry your most valuable, essential and fragile items (preferable a change of clothes, also) in your carry-on pack. Try to fit everything into a single checked duffel bag, in addition to a rod tube and a carry-on pack. I carry on my reels also.

Most Important

- Passport or birth certificate with raised seal and picture ID
- Airline Ticket
- Cash/Traveler's checks

Clothing

- Long and short shirts for fishing (3)
- Tropical weight pants/shorts for fishing (2)
- Casual pants (1)
- Casual Shorts (2)
- T-Shirts (3)
- Socks, sweat socks
- Teva-type sandals or sneakers
- Fishing cap or wide brim hat
- Lightweight jacket or sweats with hood for morning and evening

Other

- Sunscreen/lip balm
- Toiletries
- Personal medications
- Sunglasses (and spare pair)
- Camera and film
- Aloe Vera gel for sunburn
- Pepto Bismol/Immodium (tablets)
- Insect repellent
- Needle nose pliers

FISHING TACKLE

Hard Baits

- 4- ½ oz. Chrome, Blue back, Orange belly Rattletraps
- 6- ½ oz. – ¾ oz. Chrome Jigging Spoons
- 4- ¾ oz. Bill Dance Fat Free Shad- shad colors
- 2- Shallow Running Crankbaits
- 2- #13 Rapala jerkbaits, my favorite is the chartreuse and white
- 8- Assorted Bassmex Spinnerbaits ½ - ¾ oz. Colors: White, Chartreuse
- 3- Bassmex Buzzbaits ¼ - ½ oz.

Soft Baits

- 2 Bags Super Flukes, Bass Assassins, Sluggos, White Yamamoto El Sinko
- 4 Bags 8 – 10" worms, colors: black/blue tail, tequila sunrise, watermelon
- 4 Bags 6" lizards; same colors
- ¼ - ¾ oz. Bullet weights.

Top Water

- 2- Bassmex Pop-n-Runs
- 2- Bassmex Pop-a-Tops
- 2- Zara Spooks
- 2- Pop-R's
- 2- Clear Baby Torpedos

Rods

Three of your favorite bass rods, be sure they are in good condition and bring one extra multi-purpose rod.

Line & Hooks

Clear 15-20 lb. Test is recommended, as there is a lot of brush and rocks, bring enough to respool one time. We recommend 3/0, 4/0 and 5/0 worm hooks, at least 20.
